Minutes of a meeting of Upleadon Parish Council held on Thursday 15 February 2024 at Upleadon Village Hall at 6.45 pm.

7.1 Apologies and approval for absence

Apologies were received from Cllr E Wood

7.2 Declarations of Interest

There were no Declarations of Interest

7.3 To give consideration to Planning application

P1656/23/FUL Land North Of, Lower House Farm, Gloucester Road, Upleadon Change of use of land for the siting of two log cabins for holiday occupation, parking, cycle storage and track with associated works (Farm diversification scheme)

Cllr Mrs Fabian proposed No Objection, seconded by Cllr Rickard and agreed by five votes in favour, one against.

7.4 To give consideration to consultation. Motorsport UK – consultation on 3 Shires Stages Rally – Cheltenham Motor Club 14/15 Sept 2024 (note: the Rally may not pass through the Parish this year, and that it is intended it will be held in reserve in case another of the intended routes becomes unavailable).

Cllr Rickard proposed that in response to the consultation that the Parish Council emphasise the importance of safety and that it must be paramount. In addition how much notice will be given when deciding if the Okle Green stage will be used. This was seconded by Cllr Mrs Fabian and unanimously agreed.

7.5 Grit Bin – recently sited at Upleadon Church

A discussion took place regarding the newly sited grit bin at Upleadon Church which was not of a size/design that Members were expecting it to be. County Cllr Mrs Moseley who had been instrumental in obtaining grit bins for local Parishes in her area through the County Council, advised she was aware of the situation and discussed with Members an alternative type and advised she would ask for two bins – one in a subtle colour for the Church location and a further one for siting in Forge Lane, in the vicinity of Heronsgate.
